Mounting Orchids To Trees



Tropical climates, like Florida and Hawaii, are like heaven to plants. It is amazing to see how lush and green these moist, humid areas are with their abundant plant life growing on top of other plant life. On a recent trip to Florida I was remarking to a hotel gardener how gorgeous all of the orchids looked hanging on the palm, oak and ficus trees around the property. He said they were very easy to do. You simply [tape](#) or wire the plants to the trees and then mist them several times a week! I am definitely going to try this using our new [E-Z Fuse tape](#) the next time my orchid loses all of its blooms! Not sure it will work as well in dry, temperate southern California, but we'll see!
